- The oldest continuous certificate for NC worldwide







FSC Principles





- 1. Meet all applicable laws
- 2. Have legally established rights
- 3. Respect indigenous rights
- 4. Maintain community well-being
- 5. Conserve economic resources
- 6. Protect biological diversity
- 7. Have written management plan
- 8. Engage in regular monitoring
- 9. Conserve high conservation value forests
- 10. Manage plantations to alleviate pressures on natural forests.

Environmentally sound





- Continuous forest cover provides habitat for wide ranging and vulnerable species (e.g. goshawk)
- Use of conservation zones for RTE species and rare communities
- 240 acre bogs designated as High Conservation Value Forest
- Use of Integrated Pest Management strategies
- Emphasis on species and age class diversity, and variable patch size consistent with natural disturbance regimes
- Consistent BMP implementation and protection of streams and other water resources

Economically viable





- Over a century in the forest management business
- Long term strategy to expand the forest land base
- Purchasing and investing in restoration of degraded forest lands
- Mission statement includes pledge to shareholders to provide predictable and appropriate ROI
- Full array of products and markets
- Consistent investment in forestry and land management operations
